ZERO INCIDENTS THROUGH COLLABORATION

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- Many people are now free to help in kids' classes/schools, sports teams, community events, side jobs/family work etc.
- One of the operational challenges is that with many employees taking either Monday or Friday off, scheduling meetings has become more difficult, as everyone is now trying to book meetings between Tuesday and Thursday.
- An interesting factor is the positive feedback from crew members' families, who have noted a significant difference when our team works on an Andersen flex-scheduled project.

Make it Easy

- If it is difficult for employees to get to location, they will likely not attend.
- Have activities in work areas. More visibility also creates more engagement.
- Align with Break Times (before or after) so it doesn't conflict with other work.
- Keep activities short (15 minutes)
- If multiple trades, schedule at different times to limit "Wait times"



Making it Easy

Example:

Purpose:

- Train crews in importance of knowing how to lower lifts in an emergency.
- Different lifts may have different lowering controls.

Location:

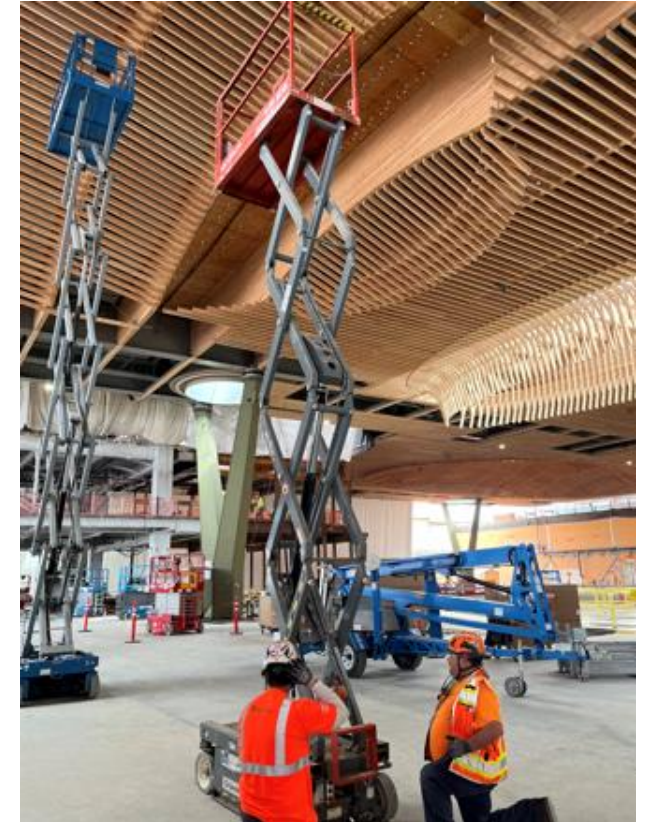
- Center of Project for high visibility & ease of accessibility.

Timing:

- Sign-Up times
- Two-person teams
- No more than 10 minutes

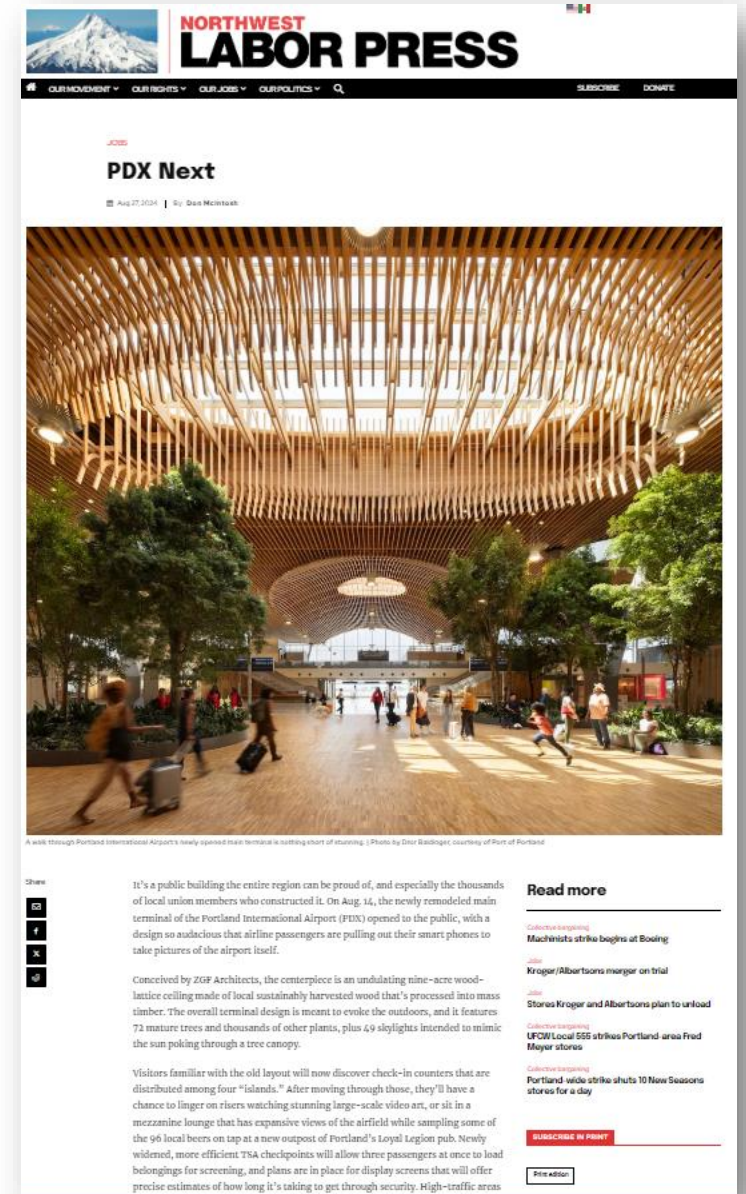
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To make it last

- Management support.
- Continued conversations.
- Follow up on concerns. Loop back results.
- EHS team has established a solution-based culture.
Aka. not “safety cop.”
 - Workforce asking questions due to trust built.
 - Proactive vs. Reactive

“Really, it’s about the people who do this work, and if you’re not thinking about them first, something’s wrong,” Robinhold said. “I heard it from our own guys, an electrician on the job said, ‘You guys are walking your talk.’”
